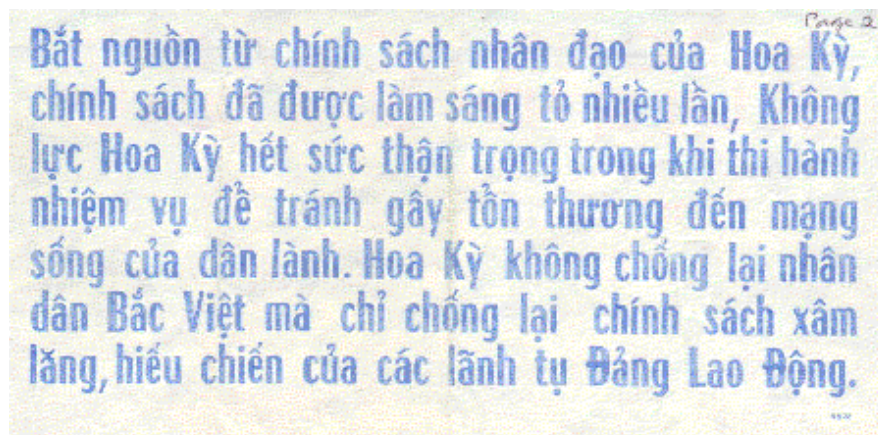


### AREAS WHICH HAVE BEEN RESTORED (BY THE COMMUNIST) WILL BE BOMBED AGAIN
